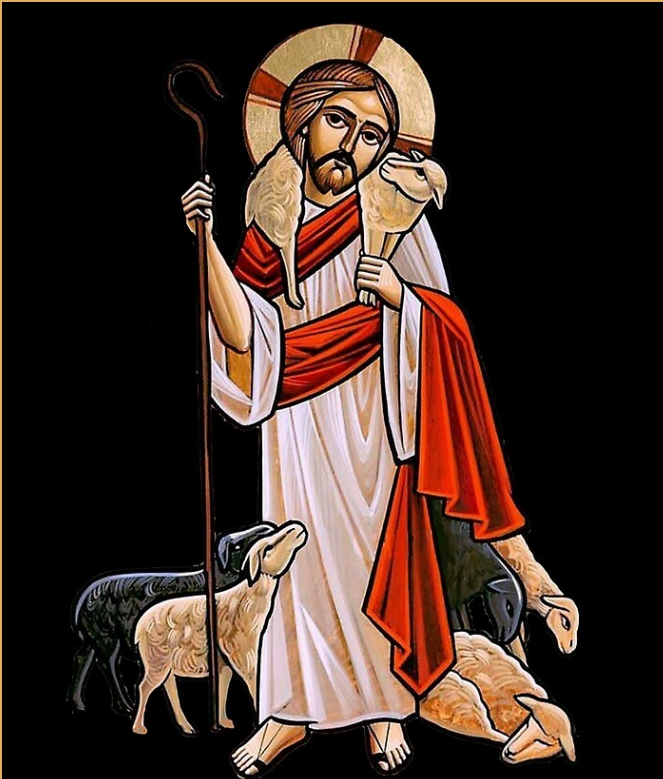

- ✦ The celebrant will place the bread in your hands.
- ✦ If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.
- ✦ To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.
- ✦ If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.
- ✦ If you prefer to receive a blessing, cross your arms over your chest.

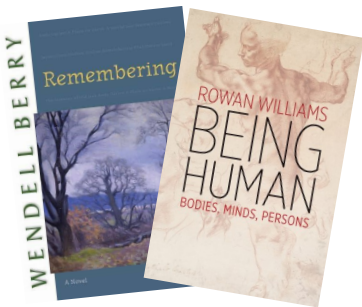
