


Holy Eucharist Trinity Sunday

The Communion

All who are baptized in any Christian church and seek to follow Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour may receive the bread.

- + To receive the bread, hold out your hands, crossed with palms up.
- + The celebrant will place the bread in your hands.
- + If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.
- + To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.
- + If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.
- + If you prefer to receive a blessing, cross your arms over your chest.
