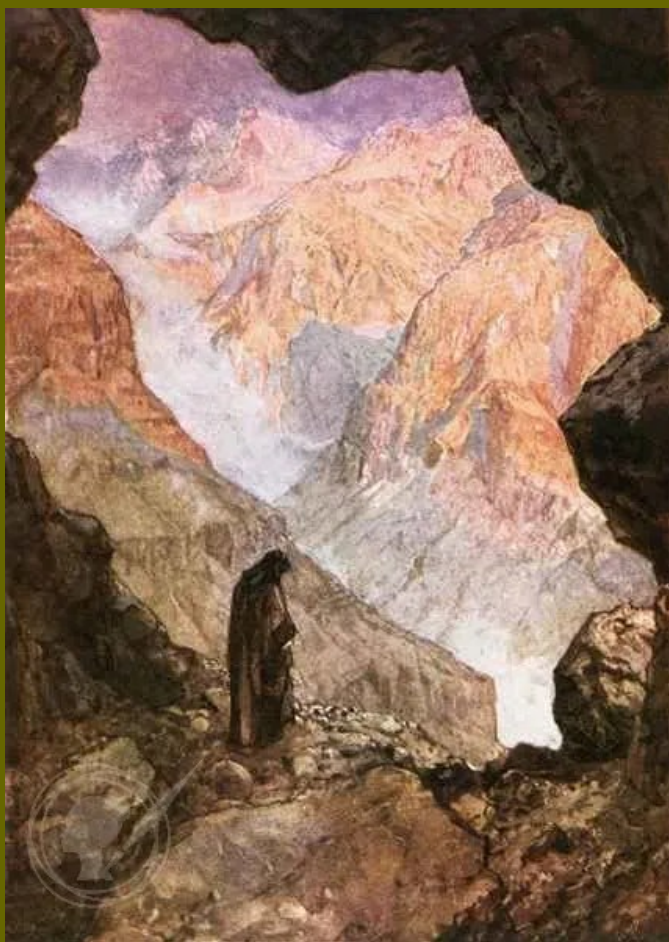




# Holy Eucharist

- ✦ *If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.*
- ✦ *If you prefer to receive a blessing, cross your arms over your chest.*

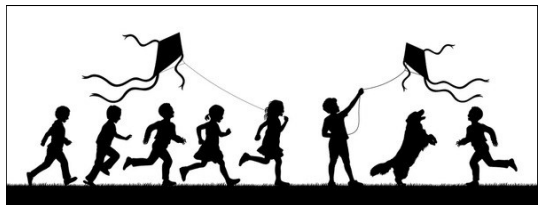


### **SAY YES! TO KIDS FUNDRAISER—TODAY AFTER THE SERVICE**
