


Holy Eucharist St. Peter and St. Paul

Prayer for Medical Care in Moose Jaw

Recently, Dr. Brad Thorpe brought to our attention, at St. Aidan, the severity of the situation of the shortage of doctors in Moose Jaw and the impact of that on access to care for residents of our area. He asked us to pray about this as our doctors in the city have been meeting, in preparation, to meet with government and SHA officials to discuss this. On Thursday, July 3, 2025 from 7 PM to 9PM, all of the family doctors in our city, have been invited to meet with the leadership teams of the Ministry of Health and Saskatchewan Health Authority to begin to discern a "made in Moose Jaw" plan/solution to provide residents of our community and area better access to medical care.

We encourage you to please uphold this in your prayers in the upcoming days, praying for discernment and guidance for all involved as they work towards better access to care for all in our area.
