DIOCESE OF QU’APPELLE, PWRDF JOIN GROW HOPE SASKATCHEWAN

PWRDF is pleased to announce that the Diocese of Qu’Appelle and PWRDF have joined Grow Hope Sask, a project of the Canadian Foodgrains Bank, that raises funds to end hunger all over the world.

How Grow Hope works: Farmers donate land to plant and grow a crop for Grow Hope Saskatchewan. Churches and parishioners raise money to help cover the costs of raising the crop. It costs up to \$350 per acre to provide seed, fertilizer, fuel and other things needed to grow food. After harvest, farmers sell the crop and donate the proceeds to Canadian Foodgrains Bank. The proceeds can be as much as \$600 per acre, or more. Crop proceeds that are used to provide emergency food assistance for people living through a crisis may be matched 4:1 through the Canadian Foodgrains Bank’s Partnership with Global Affairs Canada.

Our membership in the Foodgrains Bank allows us to expand our reach around the world and make a bigger impact by collaborating with other member agencies. This ecumenical project provides a way to work together towards a common goal of ending hunger.
