If the door is closed, feel free to wait on the pew.

JESSE'S ORDINATION – ALL ARE INVITED!



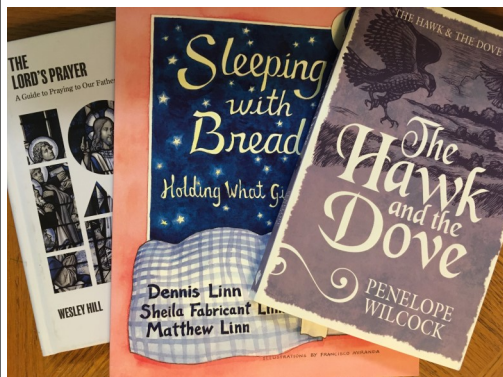
Our own Rev. Jesse Miller will be ordained to the priesthood on Sept 10 at St. Paul's Cathedral (Regina). Details to follow.
