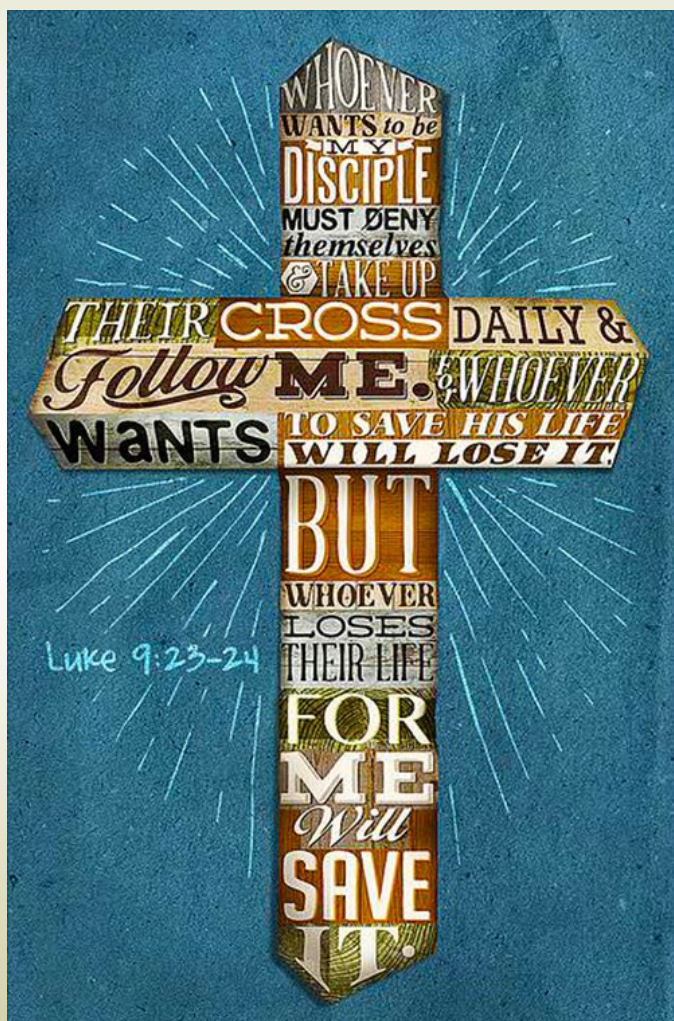

GODLY PLAY TEACHERS OR HELPERS NEEDED

As the 2023-2024 Children's Ministry school season begins, we are now down to four teachers involved in our Godly Play curriculum for ages 4 to Grade 5. Because many of us currently involved in teaching the children are also involved in other

ministries on Sunday morning, more teachers or helpers would be great.

Each Sunday, we need two adults "at arm's length" (not related or married to each other) with clear criminal record check. (Michelle, our Parish Administrator, can assist with the paperwork for the CRC when she is back to work.)

The Godly Play curriculum (used most of the Sundays in the year) has a distinct format every week, much like the distinct format of our liturgical service upstairs, but only one Bible story (which I'll schedule) and a few different ways we use to help the children connect with the story.

In early September, I will provide new teachers and helpers with training and orientation of the Godly Play program and the layout of our space.
