- + The celebrant will place the bread in your hands.
- + If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.
- + To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.
- + If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.
- + To receive a blessing instead, cross your arms over your chest.
- For specific prayer, make your way to the prayer room (SE corner of the nave) after you are served. If the door is closed

### SUPERVISED NURSERY HOPES


We are blessed with a growing number of young children and would like to offer parents a supervised nursery during the service. Please talk to Sarah McLean if you are interested in participating in this ministry.
