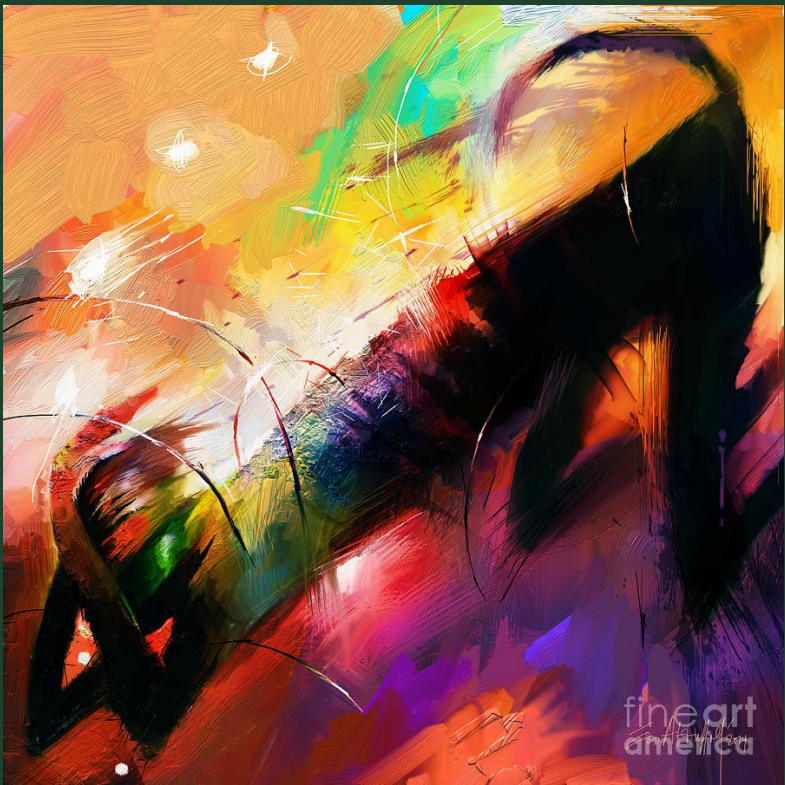




# Holy Eucharist

*All who are baptized in any Christian church and seek to follow Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour may receive communion.*

- ✦ *To receive the bread, hold out your hands, crossed with palms up.*
- ✦ *The celebrant will place the bread in your hands.*
- ✦ *If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.*
- ✦ *To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.*
- ✦ *If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.*
- ✦ *To receive a blessing instead, cross your arms over your chest.*
- ✦ *For specific prayer, make your way to the prayer room (SE corner of the nave) after you are served. If the door is closed, please wait on the pew.*

Your food donations may be brought to the church on Sunday Oct 9th to place in baskets in front of the Altar.

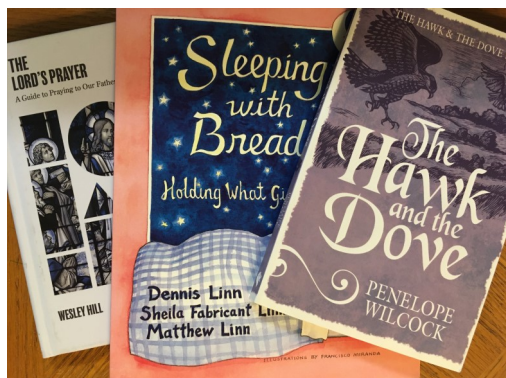
