Anticipating the increased stipend and housing allowance that we will have the opportunity to pay to our full-time incumbent, Fr. Louis, could be a stressful reality. Instead, at the end of August, we have covered all our expenses to date and are on track to have the donation income to care for a full-time priest for the final months of the year. That means our giving exceeds our expenses to the end of August!

Note: a handful of ministries are paid for from other sources and we received ~\$16,500 in bequests this year above and beyond general giving.
