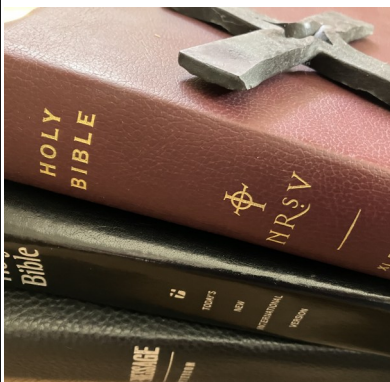

SUNDAY MORNINGS WITH NATHAN – Oct 19 - Nov 9 at 9AM

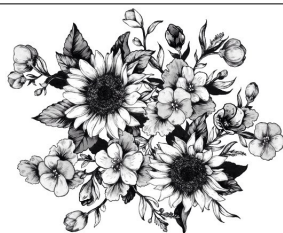


Have you ever asked: what is the Bible? why do we read it? where did it come from? is it relevant today? is it inerrant or inspired? does it matter?

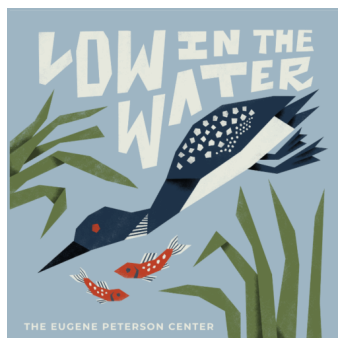

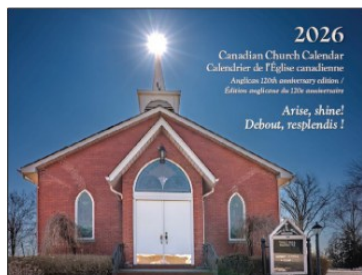
