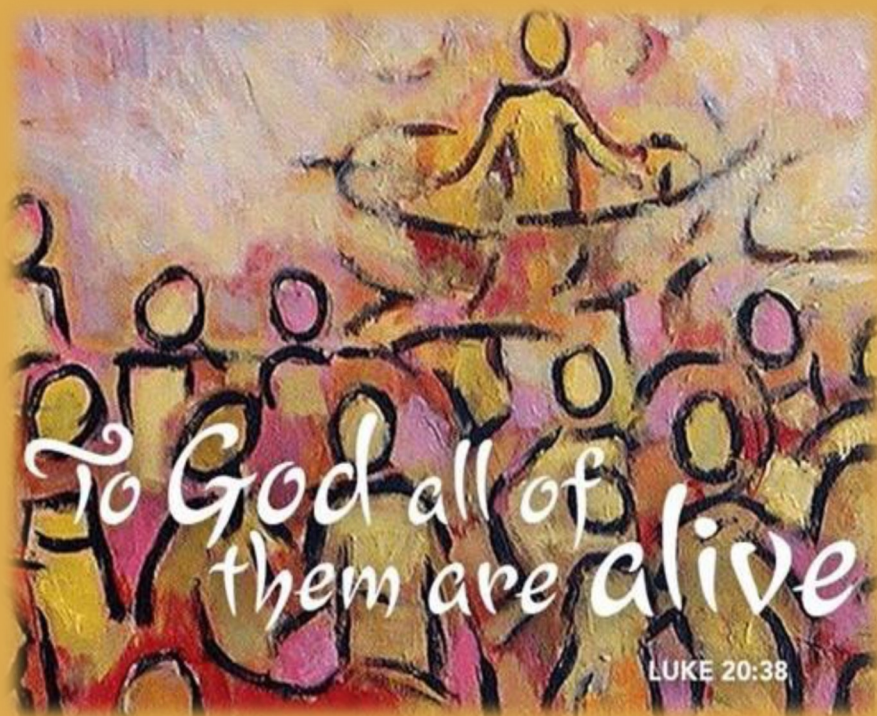




Holy Eucharist

 - ✦ *If you require gluten-free wafers, please indicate at the time of receiving.*
 - ✦ *To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.*
 - ✦ *If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.*
 - ✦ *To receive a blessing instead, cross your arms over your chest.*
 - ✦ *For specific prayer, make your way to the prayer room (SE corner of the nave) after you are served. If the door is closed, please wait on the pew.*

Do you have a song, a poem, a short story, a dance, or some other creative Christmas piece that would be a delight and joy to share?

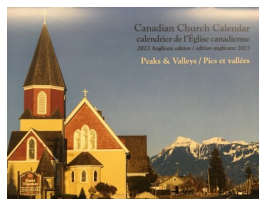
