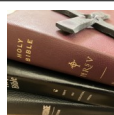

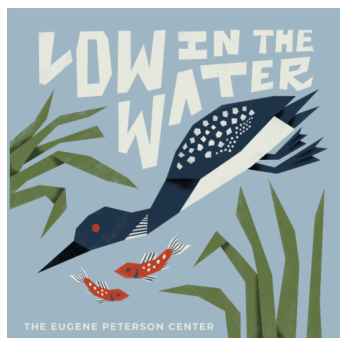
## **LITTLE PODS, BIG IDEAS—Nov 20, 7PM**

Join other Aidanites at a weekly prayer time for St. Aidan and the City of Moose Jaw.

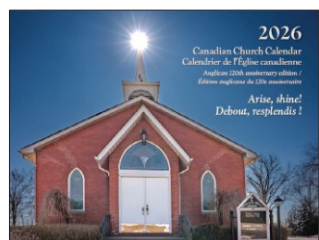
