CHRISTMAS PRESENCE—DEC 11 @ 7 PM

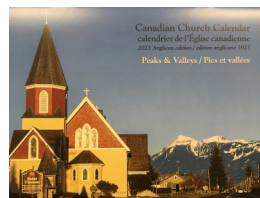
Christmas Presence is around the corner! On Gaudete Sunday, we'll gather to celebrate this mid-Advent feast day and the coming Christmas season.
