- ✦ *To receive the cup, guide it to your mouth using the base.*
- ✦ *If you prefer not to drink from the cup, bow slightly in reverence.*
- ✦ *To receive a blessing instead, cross your arms over your chest.*
- ✦ *For specific prayer, make your way to the prayer room (SE corner of the nave) after you are served. If the door is closed, please wait on the pew.*

Christmas Presence is around the corner! On Gaudete Sunday, we'll gather to celebrate this mid-Advent feast day and the coming Christmas season.

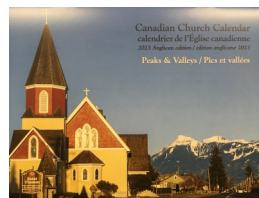
